**FID and License to Carry Application Process**

**How to apply:**

Return your completed application to the Rochester Police Department with the appropriate payment listed below in the form of a check or money order payable to the “Town of Rochester”. We **do not** accept cash and your application will not be accepted without the appropriate payment.

FID / LTC	\$100.00
FID/LTC Over 70 Years of Age (renewal)	No fee
FID 15-17 years of age (parent consent)	\$25.00
FID Restricted- Pepper Spray only (new)	\$25.00
FID Restricted- Pepper Spray only (renewal)	No fee
Law Enforcement Officer (Police ID Required)	\$25.00

**Safety Certificate:**

First time applicants and applicants whose permit has been expired more than 5 years must submit a copy of a firearms safety class certificate.

**When to Apply:**

License renewals will be accepted no more than 4 months before your current permit expires.

**Appointment for Fingerprints & Photographs:**

When you return your application, you will choose an appointment time to come back for your pictures and fingerprints. Your appointment date must be at least 7 days after you drop of your completed application to allow us time to conduct the required background checks.

The officer that you have your appointment with does them while they are on patrol duty. Emergency calls may result in the officer being delayed or require us to reschedule your appointment. If this happens we will try and accommodate you as quickly as possible.

**Questions:**
